Materials

Powder-coated aluminium

Care & Maintenance

ALUMINIUM is a lightweight, yet strong and durable material and ideal for outdoor furniture due to its resistance to corrosion. At mindo, we use state-of-the-art powder-coating techniques in our production process. Powder-coating technology is an eco-friendly and secure process to best protect and prolong outdoor furniture from weather influences as well as from minor scratches. If the coating is damaged due to dents or scratching, moisture can invade and eventually damage the aluminium. To ensure the highest quality and resistance to external factors, we carefully apply the powder coating to every frame and aluminium slat individually. This may cause a subtle variation in colour tone, that might be visible on our mindo 111 table slats under specific lighting conditions. Please note that this tonal difference has no effect on the quality of the slats or the table and will not be considered grounds for a warranty claim.

Regularly remove dirt with a sponge or soft brush, lukewarm water, and a mild dishwashing detergent. Never use solvents. Thoroughly rinse with clean, fresh water after cleaning to remove all soap and dirt residue. To remove dirt from the extension tracks, flush the tracks thoroughly with water from a garden hose. In severe cases, remove one or both table legs for better access. We recommend leaving the table in a non-extended position when not in use for longer periods of time. To avoid scratching, always place objects with a rough surface on a coaster and do not pull or slide heavy objects on the table top.

Storage

The mindo 111 collection can be left outside during the entire summer season. During the off-season, we recommend storing your furniture in a dry and ventilated place, like a covered patio or similar. This will give your furniture maximum protection and make spring cleaning easier. Alternatively, store the furniture under a furniture cover. A cover should be placed in such a manner that it is kept slightly away from the furniture to minimise condensation and allow for free air circulation. Condensation forming under the cover during storage, as well as furniture or cushions that were damp before storage, can cause mould and mildew. Therefore it is vital that the furniture as well as any cushions are completely dry before storage. Checking the stored furniture regularly and letting moisture escape by lifting the cover on dry days is helpful. We recommend storing any loose cushions upright or in a slanted position for maximum air circulation. Placing them with their backside up will protect the more visible parts if staining should occur.
