Materials & Care

ALUMINIUM is a lightweight, yet strong and durable material and ideal for outdoor furniture due to its resistance to corrosion. All our aluminium undergoes a high-quality, solvent-free powder coating for extra protection before being processed. If the coating is damaged due to dents or scratching, moisture can invade and eventually damage the aluminium. Regularly remove dirt with a sponge or soft brush, lukewarm water, and a mild dishwashing detergent. Never use solvents. Thoroughly rinse with clean, fresh water after cleaning to remove all soap and dirt residue.

BAMBOO is a natural and very strong, yet flexible material. Bamboo is not wood but a rapidly growing grass variant. As bamboo can be harvested every 4-6 years, it is considered highly sustainable. Even though a bamboo surface is very hard, it can dry out and become brittle which is why all bamboo used in mindo products has been oiled and treated with a fungicide during production.

Bamboo has very different characteristics than wood and must be cared for accordingly. We recommend giving your bamboo surfaces a light oiling with a standard furniture oil on a regular basis, depending on climate. Bamboo can slightly fade in colour due to UV and weather influences but proper care and maintenance will keep your furniture beautiful and intact for many years. A colour fade does not degrade the product.

Weather and environment will impact your furniture just like any other natural material that is placed outside. If your bamboo furniture shows signs of black or brown spots, they should be removed and the furniture treated as soon as possible.

CLEANING AND TREATING BAMBOO:

Wet the bamboo surface and scrub with a stiff brush, removing dirt and fungi. If necessary, add a small amount of dishwashing detergent. Rinse well. When the furniture is dry, it might be necessary to sand lightly with medium to fine sandpaper until all blemishes are removed. Sand evenly and always with the grain. Remove sanddust and treat the bamboo furniture immediately with a light furniture oil, applying evenly but taking care not to overapply. Let the oil dry completely prior to using your bamboo furniture.

Our **FABRIC (SUNBRELLA)** is made from high-quality, 100% solution-dyed acrylic fibers produced in France. Sunbrella is designed for outdoor use and comes with a repellent surface that is hydrophobic and delays the adhesion of stains and dirt. This effect will decrease over time depending on the climatic impact. Clean with a soft bristle brush and lukewarm water/mild soapy water. Air drying is recommended to prevent mildew. We propose cleaning the cushions regularly depending on the climate; stains and dirt should be removed swiftly after they are discovered. Do not steam-iron the fabric; only use a dry iron on the lowest temperature setting, e.g., through a cloth. It is advisable to test a small area first.

Storage & Covers

The mindo 121 collection can be left outside during the entire summer season. Storage during the off-season should be easy as the practical folding function is a space saver. We recommend storing your furniture in a dry and ventilated place, like a covered patio or similar. This will give your furniture maximum protection and make spring cleaning easier. Alternatively, store the furniture under a furniture cover. A cover should be placed in such a manner that it is kept slightly away from the furniture to minimise condensation and allow for free air circulation. Condensation forming under the cover during storage, as well as furniture or cushions that were damp before storage, can cause mould and mildew. Therefore it is vital that the furniture as well as any cushions are completely dry before storage. Checking the stored furniture regularly and letting moisture escape by lifting the cover on dry days is helpful. We recommend storing any loose cushions upright or in a slanted position for maximum air circulation. Placing them with their backside up will protect the more visible parts if staining should occur. Be sure to consult with the above care guide for bamboo before and after storing to keep your furniture in pristine condition for many years.
